MCC Public Worship Services Are Temporarily Suspended

Dear MCC Family,

As concerns continue to mount regarding COVID-19, the Coronavirus, MCC is committed to caring for both our Church family and our Marysville community. Your MCC Elders have been in prayer and frequent conversation about how our Church should respond to this very fluid situation. As always, we want to be sensitive to the leading of God's Spirit.

Based on the latest information available from our government health experts, and after much prayer and careful deliberation, we have made the decision to temporarily suspend our Sunday worship services for Sunday, March 22nd, 29th and also April 5th. **AS OF NOW, WE FULLY INTEND TO CELEBRATE THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS TOGETHER ON EASTER SUNDAY, APRIL 12TH AT 10:00**.

That being said, **the doors to MCC will be OPEN every single Sunday from 10:00** – **Noon** for anyone who feels drawn by God to come here from prayer. Communion will be available in pre-sealed cups.

While we won't meet together at MCC for worship as usual, we're excited to introduce an online version accessible from our main website, <u>www.marysvillechristian.org</u> This will include praise and worship, a communion meditation and a message from the Word of God. You will also find easy-to-follow instructions about how to set up online giving if you're interested.

We hope you will continue to support MCC through your tithes and offerings. Our mission, and expenses continue, whether we are meeting in person or not. You may either mail your check or bring your offering to the Church office "Joy Box". You can also contribute online at the MCC website, which might be the most convenient and the most secure option. We are grateful for your generosity that allows us to continue to serve during these uncertain times.

While no large gatherings will meet at MCC, our various Small Group studies may continue to meet. Check with the leader of your group or the church office for up-to-date information. We would urge you to use your best discretion about participating. Please do NOT participate if you are ill.
